II. As the Smyrna church faces intense _____ for their faith, notice Jesus’ response:

“Write this letter to the angel of the church in Smyrna. This is the message from the one who is the First and the Last, who was dead but is now alive: ‘I know about your suffering and your poverty—but you are rich!’” (Revelation 2:8-9a NLT)

B. “Do not _____, but be _____”

“Do not fear what you are about to suffer.” (Revelation 2:10a ESV)
