### I. Intro: Water and the word

### II. As Jesus begins His ministry, He is \_\_\_\_\_ by John the Baptist in the Jordan River

*Just as Jesus was coming up out of the water, he saw heaven being torn open and the Spirit descending on him like a dove. And a voice came from heaven: "You are my Son, whom I love; with you I am well pleased." (Mark 1:10-11 NIV)*

#### A. An often asked question: "\_\_\_\_\_ was \_\_\_\_\_ baptized?"

*But John tried to talk him out of it. "I am the one who needs to be baptized by you," he said, "so why are you coming to me?" But Jesus said, "It should be done, for we must carry out all that God requires." So John agreed to baptize him. (Matthew 3:14-15 NLT)*

*For our sake he made him to be sin who knew no sin, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God. (2 Corinthians 5:21 ESV)*
