- B. When all seems \_\_\_\_\_, God's not \_\_\_\_\_ yet

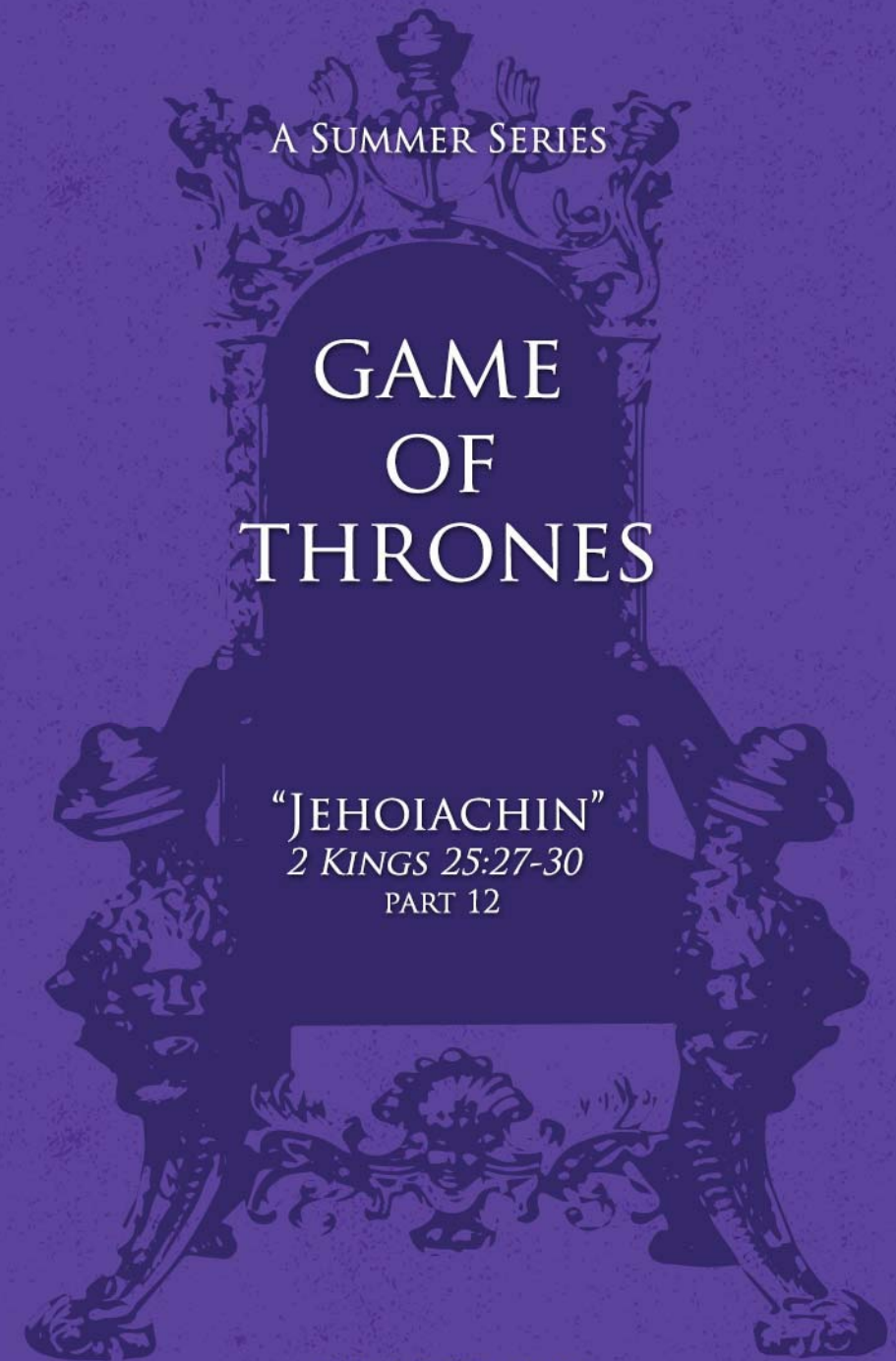
