**Comeback Plan**  
**Facility Usage, Bible Study, & Groups**  
*June 17, 2020*

We are ready to take the next step in resuming activities at Redeemer. The following guidelines are drafted by Church Council in accordance with the Missouri District, DHHS, CDC, and the Governor's "Show-Me Strong Recovery Plan." As has been indicated previously, this is not just flicking a switch, but more like a slow turn of the dial on a thermostat, as we gradually return to life together as the Body of Christ.

While we turn the dial once again and move into Phase 2 of the governor's plan, Covid-19 is still with us. As stated in previous updates, things will likely not go back to "normal" for some time. Thus, we ask that you share grace and be grace toward others during this emotional time. As leaders, we are striving to make this a safe experience for all. This has been a learning and growing time for us all.

**General Guideline**

- Anyone planning to attend any Redeemer function should be symptom free and not considered "at-risk." We also ask that if you have any common cold or flu-like symptoms, even if you think it is just allergies, to not attend in-person worship or other activities that day.
- Though not required, social distancing will be encouraged.
- Please know, you are welcome to wear a mask and/or gloves.
- Chairs and high touch spaces will be sanitized after use.

**Bible Study**

- On Sunday mornings, a single Bible Study will be offered in the Family Life Center (FLC) between church services at 9:45am, starting July 12.
- To allow for adequate people flow, cleaning between services, and overall movement on Sunday mornings, the Family Life Center will be utilized for adult Bible Study.
- Weekday studies can resume anytime, pending leader availability and group decision.

**Coffee, etc.**

- Coffee and possibly donuts will be available in the Fellowship Hall prior to Church Service starting immediately and during Bible Study in the FLC on July 12.

**Other Activities**

- Family Life Center reservations will be handled on a case-by-case basis. Groups using the FLC are expected to return the room set-up how they found it and wipe down chairs and other high-touch places upon completion of the building usage. Cleaning supplies (Lysol wipes or rubbing alcohol – 70% isopropyl alcohol) will need to be provided by the renter. Social distancing is encouraged.
- Activities will be handled on a case-by-case basis until we resume regular activities without restrictions.
